PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Chicago is a welcoming and diverse city, home to a number of cultures and communities that fortify its reputation; and

WHEREAS, immigrant communities have undoubtedly helped to shape the economic, educational, technological, and greater cultural fabric of the City of Chicago; and

WHEREAS, Chicago is home to the largest Mexican population in the Midwest and the second largest in the United States; and

WHEREAS, Chicago is celebrated for its world-class universities and a hub for burgeoning high-tech industries; and

WHEREAS, the Mexican Talent Network, a global organization of highly skilled Mexican migrants possessing expansive expertise in a wide range of areas, focuses on exposure to higher education, science, and technology to create and foster relationships between the countries they reside in and Mexico; and

WHEREAS, the Mexican Talent Network currently has 26 local chapters in cities throughout the United States, and countries around the world; and

WHEREAS, the Chicago Chapter of the Mexican Talent Network will be officially launched during the opening ceremony of the 100th Informative Conference on High-Skilled Diasporas at DePaul University on November 14, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the 100th Informative Conference on High-Skilled Diasporas, organized by the Mexican Ministry of Foreign Affairs' Institute for Mexicans Abroad and the Consulate General of Mexico in Chicago with the support of DePaul University and UNAM-Chicago, will take place November 13-16, 2013 in Chicago:
